
From the Pastor's Desk:



Happy New Year from the Administrative Team! We hope you have a great 2024! We will begin the New Year with completion of the 2024 Ministry Budget, which will be presented at the January Church Conference for Church approval. The Administrative Team meeting for December consisted of the usual reviews of the financial reports, investments, and a discussion of the church insurance policies and then spent the rest of the meeting continuing to work on the 2024 Budget.

This month's Constitution & By-Laws section features a revision to the Guidelines for use of Sanctuary, Family Ministry Center, and the Education Building. Specifically, about the change to the dancing policy. The change is to Section A, paragraph o, which previously stated that dancing is not permitted on church property. It has been revised as follows: For weddings only, the Traditional first dances are permitted (that is dancing by the bride and groom, father and daughter, mother and son and parents) at a wedding reception held in the Family Ministry Center. Dancing is not permitted at any other location on church property.

All music, live or otherwise must be approved by the Worship Ministry Team. Music selections must be classical or Christian. A BTC trained sound team member will operate the sound equipment. At the close of the traditional dances, dancing will cease. Soft music of the same kind may continue under the guidance of the BTC sound team member. At no time are D/J's permitted.
