

ARTICLE XI (Approved 5/14/03)

Adoption and Amendments

General

This constitution shall be considered adopted and in immediate effect if and when 75% of the members present at the business meeting at which vote is taken shall vote in favor of same. This vote shall be taken not less than thirty days after formal presentation of the constitution to the church, and notice of such meeting in which the vote is to be taken shall be given at least one week in advance.

A. Constitution Amendments

This constitution may be amended, altered or repealed by a 75% vote of the members present at any regular business meeting of the church. Such amendment, alteration or repeal must be given to the clerk in writing at a <u>regular scheduled</u> church conference. A vote on said amendment, alteration, or repeal will not be acted on by the church prior to the next <u>regular scheduled</u> church conference.

B. Copy of Constitution

A copy of this Constitution and By-Laws shall be kept by the clerk at all times among her records and another copy shall be kept in the church office and all amendments to, or revisions thereof, shall be prepared by the clerk and attached to copies of the Constitution and By-Laws and made available to the church members upon request.
